PRESCHOOL LEVELS 1 - 5

COST: \$47.25

The Preschool Program gives children a head start on learning to swim. Preschool Programs develop fundamental physical literacy skills for aquatic activities.

In our preschool program we work to ensure 3 - 5 year olds become comfortable in the water and have fun developing a foundation of water skills. We incorporate Lifesaving Society Water Smart® education in all Preschool levels.

Swim for Life - Preschool Level 1

These preschoolers will have fun learning to get in and out of the water. We'll help them jump into chest deep water. They'll float and glide on their front and back while wearing lifejackets. They will also learn to get their faces wet and blow bubbles underwater.

Swim for Life - Preschool Level 2

These preschoolers learn to jump into chest-deep water by themselves and get in and get out wearing a lifejacket. They'll submerge and exhale underwater. They will also be introduced to rollovers, glides and flutter kicks all while wearing lifejackets.

Swim for Life - Preschool 3

These youngsters will try both jumping and a sideways entry into deep water while wearing a lifejacket. They'll recover objects from the bottom of waist deep water. They'll work on kicking and gliding through the water on their front and back.

Swim for Life - Preschool Level 4

Advanced preschoolers will learn to do solo jumps into deeper water and get out by themselves. They'll do sideways entries and open their eyes underwater. They'll master a short swim on their front wearing a lifejacket and gliding and kicking on their side. New challenges such as pendulum rollovers onto the back and treading of water using the sculling action with hands are presented at this level.

Swim for Life - Preschool 5

These skilled preschoolers will demonstrate that they can support themselves in deep water for 10 seconds using the sculling action and a supportive kick. Wearing a lifejacket, they will practice a forward roll entry into deep water. Whip kick, back crawl and interval training will also be introduced. Preschool 5 graduates will be prepared to enter Swimmer 1 at 5 years of age.

The Swimmer Program makes sure children learn the fundamental physical literacy skills for aquatic activities. Progressions accommodate 5 - 12 year olds, including beginners and swimmers who want to build on the basics.

Lots of in-water practice develops solid swimming strokes and skills. Water Smart® education is part of every level.

Swimmer 1

This level is the foundation for swimming skill development. These beginners will become comfortable jumping into water with and without a lifejacket. They'll learn to open their eyes, exhale and hold their breath underwater. They'll work on floats, glides and kicking through the water on their front and back.

They'll cap it all off with front crawl sprints over 25 m and 4 x 25 m front or back crawl interval training.

Swimmer 5

These swimmers will master shallow dives, cannonball entries, eggbeater kicks, and in-water backward somersaults. They'll refine their front and back crawl over 50 m swims of each, and breaststroke over 25 m. Then they'll pick up the pace in 25 m sprints and two interval training bouts: 4×50 m front or back crawl; and 4×15 m breaststroke.

Swimmer 6

These advanced swimmers will rise to the challenge of sophisticated aquatic skills including stride entries, compact jumps and lifesaving kicks like eggbeater and scissor kick. They'll develop strength and power in head-up breaststroke sprints over 25 m. They'll easily swim lengths of front crawl, back crawl, and breaststroke, working their way up to the 300m workout swim.




